## **Creating an Email Account – Thunderbird**

The following guide contains steps to creating a new Email Account in Thunderbird. Before you begin you will need 4 pieces of information:

1 – Username. Your username is the email address provided to you by Uniserve.

2 – Password. This is the password associated with your Username.

3 – Incoming Server (POP3). This will depend on your domain; refer to the Email Server Settings by Domain (link here) to find this.

4 – Outgoing Server (SMTP). This will always be mail.uniserve.com for all Uniserve customers.

Once you have those pieces of information we are ready to begin.

To create a new Account, click on Tools and then E-mail Accounts, this will open a new window.



On the lower left click the Account Actions button, and then "Add Mail Account..." to start the Mail Account Setup wizard.

After clicking the Stop button, the Manual Setup button will be available, click the Manual Setup button to proceed.

Enter your full email address in Username field. In the Incoming server field, enter the POP server you found earlier. Select POP from the drop down box. In the Outgoing field enter mail.uniserve.com and then select SSL/TLS from the drop box on the right. Make sure the SMTP port is set to 465 as well.

With the information entered, click the Re-Test Configuration button next.
